SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORIES

BUSINESS SKILLS: This scholarship is awarded to current or aspiring managers or supervisors employed full-time in any of MITO's industries. It covers the programme fee for MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Business (First Line Management) (Level 4) programme commencing in 2022. Up to 10 scholarships are available.

BUSINESS SKILLS - MĀORI OR PACIFIC PEOPLES: These scholarships are awarded to current or aspiring managers or supervisors employed full-time in any of MITO's industries. They cover the programme fee for MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Business (First Line Management) (Level 4) commencing in 2022. Up to 10 scholarships are available for applicants of Māori ethnicity and up to 10 scholarships are available to applicants of a Pacific Peoples ethnicity.

MITO ALUMNI – DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS*: This scholarship covers the programme fee for the New Zealand Diploma in Business (Leadership and Management) (Level 5), to be completed at any Te Pūkenga subsidiary** commencing in 2022. Applicants must have completed MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Business (First Line Management) (Level 4) and be employed full-time in any of MITO's industries. Up to five scholarships are available.

MITO ALUMNI – DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS - MĀORI OR PACIFIC PEOPLES*: These scholarships cover the programme fee for the New Zealand Diploma in Business (Leadership and Management) (Level 5), to be completed at any Te Pūkenga subsidiary** commencing in 2022. Applicants must have completed MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Business (First Line Management) (Level 4) and be employed full-time in any of MITO's industries. Up to five scholarships are available for applicants of Māori ethnicity and up to five scholarships are available to applicants of a Pacific Peoples ethnicity.

MITO ALUMNI – ELECTRIC VEHICLE: This scholarship covers the programme fee for MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Electric Vehicle Automotive Engineering (Level 5) commencing in 2022. Applicants must have completed a MITO automotive apprenticeship and be employed full-time in the automotive industry. Up to five scholarships are available.

MITO ALUMNI – ELECTRIC VEHICLE - MĀORI OR PACIFIC PEOPLES: These scholarships cover the programme fee for MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Electric Vehicle Automotive Engineering (Level 5) commencing in 2022. Applicants must have completed a MITO automotive apprenticeship and be employed full-time in the automotive industry. Up to five scholarships are available for applicants of Māori ethnicity and up to five scholarships are available to applicants of a Pacific Peoples ethnicity.

AUTOMOTIVE PARTS AND ACCESSORIES*: This scholarship covers the programme fee for MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Automotive Parts and Accessories (Level 3) commencing in 2022. Applicants must be employed full-time in the automotive industry and have not been previously enrolled in a MITO training programme. Up to 10 scholarships are available.

CLYDE CUNNINGHAM QSM MEMORIAL: This scholarship covers the programme fee for MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Business (First Line Management) (Level 4) commencing in 2022. Applicants must have completed a MITO automotive apprenticeship and be employed full-time in the automotive industry based in the Hawke's Bay region. Up to two scholarships are available.

DUNCAN "SANDY" FRASER MEMORIAL: This scholarship covers the programme fee for MITO's New Zealand Certificate in Business (First Line Management) (Level 4) commencing in 2022. Applicants must have completed a MITO automotive apprenticeship and be employed full-time in the automotive industry based in the Wellington region. Up to two scholarships are available.

*If you're eligible for the Government's two years' of fees-free industry training you are not eligible to receive the MITO Alumni - Diploma in Business (including Māori and Pacific Peoples scholarships) or Automotive Parts and Accessories scholarships.
