

JANET LANE MNZM SCHOLARSHIP

Please read these terms and conditions carefully to ensure your application is considered.

- The Janet Lane MNZM scholarship for a future leader pays the programme fee for either the Bachelor of Applied Management with a Te Pūkenga subsidiary, a university Graduate Diploma or a management, leadership, governance and strategy course at Harvard University (or similar). In addition, MITO - Te Pūkenga will organise a programme of follow-up coaching to build upon the leadership development.
- The successful recipient is to submit a report three months into the commencement of study and once the qualification/course is completed.
- One scholarship is available, up to \$20,000.
- You must be a New Zealand citizen or resident.
- You must be working full-time in the automotive, extractives, gas or transport and logistics industry.
- Applicants will have completed an NZQA recognised programme of study at Level 5 or above and demonstrated leadership qualities both at work and within their community.
- Applicants will have held a supervisory management position for a minimum of two years.
- The scholarship will not be awarded to applicants that are enrolled in another training programme with any other tertiary provider.
- The scholarship must be started within one year of it being awarded.
- The scholarship can only be awarded once per person and is not transferable to another person.
- The scholarship is not transferable to another place of employment should you change employer before the scholarship is completed, unless the new employer is within the same industry and they are willing to support you; and your previous employer and MITO - Te Pūkenga both agree to the transfer.
- MITO - Te Pūkenga will publish details of the scholarship recipients and may ask for further information to help promote MITO - Te Pūkenga's training programmes and the scholarship programme.
- A selection panel will be convened by the MITO - Te Pūkenga Executive Director. The panel reserves the right to request further supporting information. The panel's decision is final.
- Incomplete applications or applications received after 5pm, Friday 24 November 2023 will not be considered.
