

Designed in consultation with industry, MITO's training programme will provide new or existing Heavy Vehicle Drivers with the skills and knowledge required to safely and competently operate heavy combination vehicles, to ensure efficient heavy haulage transportation.

Programme outline

The Level 4 work-based programme is expected to take 11 months to complete.

The programme involves paper-based theoretical training and assessment with some online content, and task-based practical training and assessment that is undertaken in the workplace. Experienced industry assessors will also support learners through their programme.

Entry requirements

You must be employed full-time in the industry and hold the correct vehicle licence to enrol in this programme.

Programme fee
