

Designed in consultation with industry, MITO's training programme will provide new or existing heavy vehicle drivers with the skills and knowledge required to safely and competently operate heavy combination vehicles, to ensure the efficient transportation of logs.

Programme outline

The Level 4 work-based programme is expected to take 11 months to complete.

The training programme includes a mix of practical training and assessment, undertaken in the workplace, and eLearning, allowing you to complete theory elements of the programme at your own pace. You will have access to videos, learning activities and course assessments, which can be easily accessed at any time and from any device – mobile phone, tablet or PC. Experienced industry assessors will also support learners through their programme.

Entry requirements

You must be employed full-time in the industry and hold the correct vehicle licence to enrol in this programme.

2024 programme fee

\$781 (excluding GST). Note this is a fixed fee and is non-refundable. Some learners may be eligible for the Government's Fees Free scheme (up to two year's free fees) – check your eligibility at feesfree.govt.nz.
