## MITO LOG TRANSPORT OPERATOR PROGRAMMES

MITO's training programmes for log transport operators provide a career path for drivers, from new entrants to the industry to highly skilled drivers.

### TRANSPORTATION OF LOGS BY ROAD

MITO's National Certificate in Transportation of Logs by Road (Level 3) is for log transport operators driving heavy combination vehicles.

The compulsory unit standards ensure that drivers have the knowledge and skills for the safe, lawful and efficient transport of logs by road.

The elective unit standards allow drivers to choose skills specific to their role, such as loading a logging truck or trailer, transporting logs off-highway, and operating vehicles in forestry operations.

### COMMERCIAL ROAD TRANSPORT (GOODS SERVICE SENIOR DRIVER)

The National Certificate in Commercial Road Transport (Goods Service Senior Driver) (Level 4) is for experienced truck drivers. Holders of the certificate are able to demonstrate advanced driving techniques, mentor and manage drivers, communicate effectively and apply organisational policies and procedures.

### FIRST LINE MANAGEMENT

The National Certificate in Business (First Line Management) (Level 4) may suit experienced operators who have moved, or are moving, into business and/or people management.

The programme is aimed at current and aspiring managers and supervisors who wish to advance their business skills.

# PATHWAY TO SUCCESS

The Log Transport Safety Council's (LTSC) Pathway to Success is an accreditation programme for log transport operators, to recognise their skills and experience within the industry.

The Pathway to Success is made up of four levels of accreditation: Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum, which recognise educational and practical achievement.

The programme is open to LTSC members, and demonstrates the LTSC's commitment to improving safety outcomes in the log transport sector
