

Designed in consultation with industry, MITO's new training programme is designed for people working in entry level positions in the port operations environment. It provides the specialist knowledge and skills required to competently handle the movement of cargo, under supervision.

Programme Outline

The Level 3 programme that leads to this qualification is expected to take 13 months to complete.

The programme is delivered in-house, where approved company trainers deliver the training and registered assessors conduct assessment internally. The training programme includes a mix of practical training and assessment, undertaken in the workplace, and theory learning and assessment, allowing you to complete theory elements of the programme at your own pace.
