

MITO NEW START – ELECTRIC VEHICLE SCHOLARSHIP

Please read these terms and conditions carefully to ensure your application is considered.

- This scholarship covers the fees for MITO's Electric Vehicle Automotive Engineering Level 5 programme, commencing in 2026.
- You must hold an Automotive Engineering qualification equivalent to Level 4 on the New Zealand Qualifications and Credentials Framework (NZQCF) and be employed full-time in the automotive industry.
- To complete the programme, applicants may be required to travel to attend off-job training.
- Applicants must have the support of their employer to undertake the training programme.
- You must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
- It will not be awarded to applicants that are already enrolled in any MITO training programme, or another training programme with any other tertiary provider.
- The scholarship must be used within one year of it being awarded.
- The scholarship can only be awarded once per person and is not transferable to another person.
- The scholarship is not transferable to another place of employment should you change employer before the scholarship is completed, unless the new employer is within the same industry, and they are willing to support you; and your previous employer and MITO both agree to the transfer.
- MITO will publish details of the scholarship recipients and may ask for further information to help promote MITO's training programmes and the scholarship programme.
- A selection panel will be convened by MITO's Executive Director. The panel reserves the right to request further supporting information. The panel's decision is final.
- Incomplete applications or applications received after 5pm, 15 December 2025 will not be considered.
